

## 7<sup>th</sup> Grade Adjective Project – DUE WEDNESDAY OCTOBER 25

### Instructions:

1. Choose 1 adjective in Spanish (it may help to think first in English, but the final adjective must be in Spanish)
2. Write out/draw the adjective in a creative way (examples below).
3. Make sure the project is completed on sturdy construction paper or cardstock. You might draw the adjective itself out on normal paper, but you need to put the final project on construction paper.
4. Write your name, period and the date **ON THE BACK** of the project.

### Examples:

1. Let's suppose I choose the adjective "nublado" (cloudy). For my project I might decide to write out "nublado" where each letter looks like a cloud. And to add a bit more creative detail, maybe I will fill in the letters with cotton balls, so they look even more like clouds. I will put the adjective on blue construction paper to make "nublado" look like it is floating in the sky.
2. Or maybe I decide to go with the adjective "duro" (hard). Perhaps I decide to draw the letters of "duro" to make them look like wood or steel, or some other hard material. I could even draw a hammer, saw or nails next to the word to make it seem like the word "duro" forms part of some construction project. Once again, the final project would be completed directly on construction paper, or later transferred to construction paper.

### Grading:

You do not have to create an artistic masterpiece. I simply want your project to show signs of effort and I need to see that you have put some thought into the design of your adjective. Make sure to follow all instructions.
