

8th Grade Present-Tense Verbs Mini Project

Instructions:

1. Choose any verb (-AR, -ER or -IR ending). Be aware if the verb has any irregularity (yo-go, stem-changing, etc.). If you are unsure if a verb is regular or not, check with the teacher, or look at the following website: <http://www.spanishdict.com/conjugation>.

2. On a piece of construction paper or cardstock, you need to include three things:

- On the left side of the paper, write out the present-tense conjugation chart for the chosen verb (subject pronouns are optional). Include the infinitive and its meaning.
- Underneath the conjugation chart, you need to write a sentence in Spanish using the chosen verb. Include the English translation of the sentence.
- On the right side of the paper, draw a picture illustrating your sentence.

3. Some other guidelines to follow:

- Your project should be no larger than 11 inches x 14 inches. You are permitted to do your project on a normal white sheet of paper and then glue that to the construction paper.
- Make sure to draw the sentence illustration, and not simply use printed images. Be creative and keep your project neat and organized (and legible).
- If you want to type out the sentence and the verb chart, that is fine.
- Write your name, the date, and your class period on the **BACK** of the project.

Example:

Nadar – To swim	
Nado	Nadamos
Nadas	Nadáis
Nada	Nadan

El hombre nada con un delfín.
The man swims with a dolphin.
