- 3. What is the sound that the 'll' makes in 'calle' or 'llama'
- 4. Héctor just learned that for nouns that end in a consonant, you add 'es' to make it plural. So for the word *lápiz*, he changes it to *lápizes*. What's wrong with this? What should it be?

# Bell Work 30 de agosto

Answers:

- 1. It sounds like the 'c' in *cat* or the 'k' in *kick*.
- 2. It sounds like the 'g' in *goat* or *bag*
- 3. It sounds like the 'y' in *yell* or *yes*
- 4. We know that in Spanish the 'z' can only be followed by 'a, o, u' (Ex. zumo, zapato, tiza). Therefore, when hector gets *lápizes*, he should change the 'z' to 'c' and have the proper plural form *lápices*.
