Comic Strip Mini Project - DUE Friday, April 6th

Instructions:

1. For this assignment you will create a comic strip with eight sections, and you will draw the comic on the other side of this paper. You can create 8 boxes of equal size, or you may decide to create a comic that is divided in a different way. This is fine, as long as there are 8 different sections.

2. In the comic you will be telling any story that you want. It can be comical or serious, as long as the material is school-appropriate. You must have **at least 2 characters** depicted in your story. There is no criteria for each box in your comic - instead your comic as a whole must include the following (in Spanish):

- 3 questions
- 1 IR verb conjugated in the present tense
- 1 AR verb conjugated in the present tense

Some of your sections might only have drawings, and no dialogue. This is fine, as long as the previously mentioned elements are present somewhere in your comic.

3. You may not use any students at this school as characters in your comic. Remember that comics often use speech bubbles in order to indicate who is speaking in each section - make sure it is clear who is speaking throughout the story.

4. Write your name and period at the top of this page, and don't put anything, other than the comic itself, on the other side of the paper.

Grading:

You will be graded on following instructions, whether you put effort into this assignment, and on the grammar of the dialogue included in the comic. To show effort, make sure you are drawing clearly, using color and don't leave pencil marks. Basically, your project should look like a final product. Do your rough draft on another paper.
