## **Expressing Obligation - Guided Notes**

1. In Spanish, when we want to express “to have to do something”, we use the following formula:

---

2. We conjugate the verb \_\_\_\_\_ according to the specific subject we are talking about.

### **Examples:**

**Tengo que llevar** la camisa azul hoy.  
**I have to wear** the blue shirt today.

**Tenemos que caminar** a la biblioteca.  
**We have to walk** to the library.

3. If you want to talk about an obligation in a general sense, without using a specific subject, you will use the following phrase:

### **Examples:**

**Hay que llevar** una camisa azul hoy.

**Hay que hacer** las tareas.  
**One must do** the homework.
