“Cómo es”

- When we ask “¿Cómo estás?” or “¿Cómo está usted?” we are asking how somebody is in terms of their current mood
- When we ask “¿Cómo es...?” we are asking what somebody is like in terms of personality or physical appearance

“Tiene”

- “Tiene” is the third person singular form of the verb “Tener”, which means “to have”
- Examples for using with appearance:
 - Marta tiene los ojos verdes. (Martha has green eyes)
 - Juan tiene los brazos muy largos. (John has very long arms)
 - Felipe tiene el pelo rizado. (Philip has curly hair)

“Lleva”

- “Lleva” is the third person singular form of the verb “Llevar”, which means “to wear”
- Examples for using with appearance:
 - Marta lleva zapatos blancos. (Martha wears white shoes)
 - Juan lleva la camisa azul hoy. (John wears the blue shirt today)
 - Felipe lleva calcetines a lunares. (Philip wears polka-dot socks)
