Verbs Often Used with Indirect Object Pronouns (3/28)

The following verbs are often used with indirect object pronouns:

1. *Dar - to give*

Present Tense Conjugations	Singular	Plural

Ellos **me** dan los chocolates. → They give **me** the chocolates.

2. *Enviar - to send*

Present Tense Conjugations	Singular	Plural
1st person		
2nd person

Le envió el paquete a ella. → I send **her** the package.

3. *Mandar - to send (normal conjugation)*

Les mandamos un mensaje. → We send **them** a message.

4. *Decir - to say/tell (e→i; yo-go)*

Ustedes **nos** dicen la verdad. → You all tell **us** the truth.

5. *Escribir - to write (normal conjugation)*

Le escribes a tu madre. → You write **to your mother**.

6. Traer - to bring (yo-go)

Me traen el pan. → They bring **me** the bread.

7. Hablar - to talk/speak (normal conjugation)

Ya no **te** hablo más. → I'm not talking **to you** anymore.
